3. A letter of recommendation from a teacher;
4. A letter from your employer (if employed) and/or a letter from an adult in your community describing your contributions as an employee and /or volunteer;
5. A copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) determination of your Expected Family Contribution; and
6. A list of the colleges and universities to which you have applied. (If you need additional space, please use the form on the back of this application)
