  - 3. Essay: A personal statement that provides a sense of you as an individual, your achievements, and your hopes for the future. (maximum 1,000 words) See page 2 of Scholarship Application.
  - 4. Statement of Need: Explain your personal circumstances and how this scholarship will help you.(Maximum of 250 words) See page 2 of Scholarship Application.
  - 5. A copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) that determines your Expected Family Contribution.
  - 6. One copy of your Official High School Transcript this can be mailed or sent electronically.
